

PLACING A VALUE ON YOUR SHIPMENT

The contract that you sign with your mover provides three options for placing a value on your shipment. The value that you select sets the limit on your mover's maximum liability for loss or damage to your goods. These optional levels of liability are not insurance agreements that are governed by state insurance laws. You must make certain that your mover is aware of any high value items and you must declare a value on your Bill of Lading before the move begins.

1. You may release your goods at a value not to exceed \$.60 per pound or \$25.00 per item (whichever is less). There is no extra charge for this coverage – it is included within your contract.
2. You may declare cash value (fair market value) of your goods **on the Bill of Lading** before your goods are loaded at the rate of \$5.00 per thousand dollar value local, \$10,000.00 minimum.
3. You may declare full replacement value of your goods **on the Bill of Lading** before your goods are loaded at the rate of \$7.50 per thousand dollar value local, \$10,000.00 minimum.

Articles that are lost or damaged will, at the mover's option, either be repaired, replaced with article of like kind and quality, or a cash settlement will be made for the repairs or replacement of the articles at their current market value, regardless of the age of the lost or damaged articles.

Storage coverage is \$1.50 per thousand dollar value per month.

ALL-PRO advises all customers to thoroughly check their furniture before and immediately after the move with your mover's supervisor.

Items ALL-PRO WILL NOT be responsible for:

Loose veneer that pulls apart
Dried glue pieces that come apart
Items made from presswood
Brittle items
Unpacked or unframed glass, mirrors, and art work
Electrical or mechanical malfunctions that may occur from being moved
Boxes that are packed by the owner or someone other than an ALL-PRO employee
Driveways, sidewalks, grassy areas that can't handle the weight of our trucks
Antiques

ALL-PRO CANNOT transfer the following items:

Open box tops
Flammables
Coin collections
Firewood
Jewelry
Weapons

Cash

Liquor

Plants
Liquids
